

Nordic security white book. *Uniformity of training and technical standards in Europe's security services sector would be far better served if there was a single authority in each country dealing with all industry-related issues and to mesh with EU legislation, says a new "white book" survey of security companies across Scandinavia. This would encourage standards to move toward the highest common denominator and "make it easier to produce statistics that accurately reflect reality", it argues. Entitled "Private and public security in the Nordic countries", the new 41-page document was co-authored by CoESS (Confederation of European Security Services) and ALMEGA, the Swedish private security employers' federation.
